Paula Williams and Al Don Cisco were recognized by the Board for their many years of dedicated teaching to generations of Minford students. Plaques of appreciation were presented by Joe Stockham, Board President.

Amy O'Dell, Title One/Curriculum Supervisor gave a preliminary report on achievement scores and the Report Card. These figures show that Minford High School will be Excellent again, Minford Primary will be Excellent again and Minford Middle School will be Effective.

Superintendent Dennis Meade reported that, due to Technology Coordinator, Ryan Stockham and English/Advanced Placement Teacher, Michele McCleese's efforts, Minford High School will be receiving a grant from the Scioto Area Foundation that will help upgrade our computers using their Thin Client Technology. This will allow the most advanced software to be utilized.
