## Highlights of the April 17, 2007, Regular Meeting of the Minford Local Board of Education

Janet Smalley, Area Consultant for the Ohio Department of Education, was present to provide the Board with the results of a financial analysis that was requested. The results revealed that the District had a deficit budget projected and would be placed in "Fiscal Caution". A Budget Recovery Plan would be required to be filed with the State describing the steps to be taken and the savings realized in balancing the budget for the next two years. Factors contributing to the deficit included salaries and fringe benefit increases, capital improvement costs including the athletic complex construction costs, increased supply, utilities and maintenance costs of the larger school facilities, a 10% increase on the health insurance premiums and a declining enrollment which reduced the amount of funds provided under the State Foundation formula.


