PTO MEETING - OCTOBER 7, 2005

A meeting was held with the following present:

The following items were discussed:

Frankenmuth orders were turned in today. The orders need to be sorted and money counted since the orders need to be mailed out by Tuesday, the 11th. Lori and others will meet after school on Monday to process those orders and get them ready to mail. Frankenmuth items will be delivered on Oct 28th and we will need help in delivering those to the classrooms.
