Highlights of the January 10, 2008, Organizational and Regular Meeting of the Minford Local Board of Education

President Pro-Tempore, Joe Stockham, called the meeting to order.

Mark Caudill and John Jenkins were sworn in for their new four year term as board members.

The Board elected John Jenkins as President and Joe Stockham as Vice-President. Anita McGinnis was appointed O.S.B.A. delegate and liaison representative and Joe Stockham was appointed as O.S.B.A. student achievement delegate and liaison.

In action the Board:

- Set board compensation rates per meeting for 2008 same as last year.
- Appointed Eleanor Karshner, Treasurer, and Dennis Meade, Superintendent as purchasing agents.
- Appointed Dennis Meade as Civil Rights Coordinator/Compliance Officer for Title IX, Title VI and Section 504.
- Approved several standing authorizations.
- Continued the Board Service Fund.
- Set the time and dates for monthly meetings to be February 21st at 7:30 p.m, March 27th at 6:30 p.m. and

beginning with April, meetings will be the third Tuesday of the month, 6:30 p.m., in the High School Media Center.

 Adopted the July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009 Annual Budget.

President John Jenkins convened the regular meeting.

A sample policy addressing waivers of P.E. regulations for athletes, band and cheerleaders was reviewed. A list of health conditions and procedures was reviewed for the school nurse's use.

Elementary School Principal, Dennis Evans, presented an update on the two pre-school classes.



As you know, Minford School District was placed in "Fiscal Caution" status last spring. The financial situation was brought about due to the convergence of declining enrollment, rising operating expenses and the payment and maintenance of our athletic complex and school buildings.

One source of revenue, the FCC License lease is still under review for our renewal with the FCC and we cannot count on receipt of any funds for the near future. We are continuing to work with our Ohio Department of Education consultant concerning our recovery as we try to stay as normal as possible. I appreciate the cooperation and patience that our faculty, staff and MEA/OAPSE leadership has shown and I ask for your continued understanding as we work through this situation.
