Glenn Lawrence, 76

Glenn Owen Lawrence, 76, of Wheelersburg, died Tuesday, Sept. 12, 2006, at home after a long illness.

Glenn was born June 2, 1930, in Portsmouth, a son of the late Earl William Lawrence and Bessie Agnes Noel Lawrence. Glenn was a Korean War Veteran, a 1949 graduate of Minford High School, a 1956 graduate of Rio Grande College and a 1958 graduate of Marshall University, where he received his master's degree. He was a guidance counselor who taught for 38 years at Wheelersburg and Minford schools and attended Wheelersburg Church of Christ. Surviving are his wife, Loretta Mae Maynard Lawrence, whom he married Nov. 24, 1955, in Wheelersburg; one son, Larry Lawrence and wife, Susan, of Wheelersburg; one daughter, Sharon Chasteen and husband, Carl, of Tallahassee, Fla.; and grandchildren, Ashley, Seth, Emily and Christopher Lawrence, and Katie, Bethany and Rachel Chasteen.

He also was preceded in death by one brother, Gilbert Noel Lawrence.

Funeral services will be conducted 1 p.m. Friday, Sept. 15, 2006, at Swick-Bussa-Chamberlin Funeral Home in Wheelersburg with Don Noel officiating and burial in Memorial Burial Park with military graveside rites by the James Dickey Post 23 American Legion.
