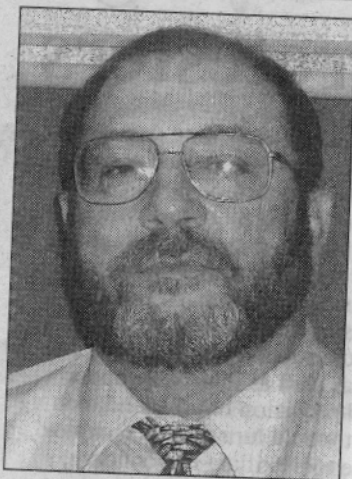


## Obituaries



### **Charles William "Charley" Flaig, 60**

Charles William "Charley" Flaig, 60, of Minford, died Tuesday, March 13, 2007.
