Helen M. Boyer Knore, 93, of Minford, died Thursday, Sept. 29, 2005, at home.

Helen was born Aug. 13, 1912, in Wheelersburg, a daughter of the late Orin L. and Anna Larcamp Boyer. She was a lifetime resident of Scioto County.
