Randolph, Indiana Western conference center is with Portsmouth along with Fyock, of Pittsburg, and Roy Witt, Tennessee's great forward passer.

'Sneeze' Achiu, the only Hawaiian playing pro football, is in a Portst. outh uniform this season along with 'Red' Joseph, stellar end. Both these players have been seen in action here when playing with Dayton.

A flock of new players will make their debut in Packer uniforms. Two of them are all-American pro team selections. "Mike' /Michaleske, formerly with the New York Yankees and 'Cal' Hubbard, who was the mainstay of the N. Y. Giants. Among the other 'orrivals' are McCrary, of Georgia; Hill, of Stanforl; Evans, of California; Kern. of Pittsburg; Young of Ohio and Laabs, of Beloit. Cully Lidberg, Minnesota's great fullback, will return to the Packer fold after coaching for two years at Colgate.

The biggest opening day crowd in history is forecast as the advance sale of tickets has climbed. Hundreds of fans from Upper Michigan and Northeastern Wisconsin have made reservations.
