

TANKS AND BEARS TO CLASH SUNDAY

Ironton Pro Eleven Slated in
Cincinnati Game With
Grange's Team

The Ironton Tanks, a professional football team which has gained much prominence of late especially because of its victory over Benny Friedman's New York Giants, of the National league, will meet with the Chicago Bears, led by Red Grange and Broncho Nagurski, both all-America players, at Cincinnati in Redland field Sunday, November 23, it was announced Tuesday by Frank Lane, who will promote the game and who is well known throughout the tri-state region as a football referee.

The Tanks, from Ironton, Ohio, are not in the National league of professional teams, but recently won over the New York Giants by 13 to 12.
