

Trio lifts Eastern Pike to win over Minford

Eastern Pike's scoring trio did it again Tuesday night.

Eric Gullett led all scorers with 21 points, and Zac Alexander and Adam Bond both finished in double figures, as the Eagles knocked off Minford on the road. Alexander had 19 points and Bond added 17 for Eastern Pike, who made 28 field goals on the night.

The Eagles slowly expanded

their lead every quarter, but the Falcons hung around in part because of Nathaniel Prater's 17 points and Nick Pendleton's 12. Minford also made six 3-pointers in the game.

"We played hard tonight, and the defensive effort was there," said Minford coach Kyle Copley. "Our offense was converting, but we got into some foul trouble early on, and those that came in did a good job of filling in the holes."
